Isabelle Redfern was born in Munich, Germany. She began her studies at the Hochschule für Musik und Theater Hannover. After studying acting and working nationwide as an actress, she furthered her studies in Music at the Universität der Künste Berlin whilst also attending private singing lessons and masterclasses with Carol Richardson-Smith, Charlotte Lehmann, John Norris and Brigitte Eisenfeld.

As an actress, Isabelle Redfern has attained great success in film, television and on stage. She has filmed with Marianne Sägebrect, Jürgen Vogel and stars in Sönke Wortmanns latest film that will be released in September 2014. She has performed at the Staatstheater Hannover, Staatsoper Hannover, Staatstheater Braunschweig, Thalia Theater Hamburg, Schaubühne am Lehniner Platz Berlin, Volksbühne Berlin and many other theaters. This season (2013/2014) she is performing at the Gorki Theater Berlin, the Ballhaus Naunynstrasse Berlin and Dieter Hallervordens Comedy Schlossparktheater Berlin. Isabelle Redfern has been inspired by working with directors such as Leander Haußmann, Robert Wilson, Hans Neuenfels, Sebastian Baumgarten, Thomas Ostermeier, Robert Lepage and George Tabori.

As a low- mezzo soprano, Isabelle Redfern was member of the festival chorus of the Bayreuther Festspiele in 2010 and 2011 and was a guest in the chorus of Oper Basel in 2012. She has performed in a variety of music theater productions at the Prater/Volksbühne Berlin, Sophiensäle Berlin, the Deutsche Theater Göttingen and the Thalia Theater, Hamburg.

Isabelle Redfern has recently been studying with dramatic soprano Miriam Gordon-Stewart. During the last year her voice has shown exciting developments, becoming increasingly at home in the dramatic mezzo repertoire, with a thrilling low extension. Ms Redfern plans to focus her future career on opera and concert performance.
